


Art Movements Related to Graphic Design

<h3><u>ART NOUVEAU</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Organic lines & shapes• Intricate patterns• Subject are often outlined• Realistic, but stylized• Earthy and more natural colors 	<h3><u>ARTS & CRAFTS</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Nature as subject matter• Highly decorative• Focus on natural beauty of materials• Colors more subdued or natural 	<h3><u>EXPRESSIONISM OR ABSTRACT-EXPRESSIONISM</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Color used to show emotion• Expressive lines, brushwork, and other elements• Distorted subject matter or non-objective 
<h3><u>ART DECO</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Symmetry• Geometric lines and shapes• Sleek, elongated figures• Influenced by Ancient Greek, Roman, & Egyptian motifs 	<h3><u>CUBISM</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Multiple perspectives or planes broken apart• Lines often used to create a "stained glass" effect• Often monochromatic• Geometric shapes 	<h3><u>POP ART</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Subject matter rooted in popular culture• Bright colors• Sometimes humorous 
<h3><u>PSYCHEDELIC ART</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Very bright colors; often multicolor• Hidden messages or meaning• Swirling & abstraction common 	<h3><u>FUTURISM</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Inspired by industry or machines• Evokes speed & energy• Focus on urban or city themes 	<h3><u>DADAISM</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Collage• Text often used• Humor & whimsy• Often satirical or political in nature 
<h3><u>SURREALISM</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Inspired by subconscious or dreams• Magical or fantasy• Psychology is a big deal in surrealism• Juxtaposition 	<h3><u>CONSTRUCTIVISM OR BAUHAUS</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clean lines & shapes, geometric forms• Primary colors with the addition of black & white• Harmony important 	<h3><u>OP ART</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shows movement• Distorts the viewers perspective & may be like an optical illusion• Lots of lines & shapes arranged in pattern• Contrasting colors often used 
<h3><u>AMERICAN KITSCH OR MID CENTURY MODERN</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• People shown in dramatic poses• Combination of organic & geometric forms• Sometimes cartoon-like• Starbursts/sunbursts common motifs - Inspired by the "space age" 	<h3><u>GRUNGE/GRAFFITI</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has a "dirty" or "weathered" look to it• Elements of graffiti such as drips, splatters, etc.• May or may not include text• Torn edges & lots of layers often overlapping 	<h3><u>MAXIMALISM</u></h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lots of bold colors, different patterns• Ornamentation & decoration are super important!• Lots of variety• No white space
